Online Instruction

- You can attend lectures either in person or on Microsoft Teams.
- To get started:
 - Install Microsoft Teams using your UTA credentials.
 - If you are enrolled in the class, you are automatically signed up for the course team “CSE 4311 XXX”, where XXX is the current semester.

Attending Lectures via Teams

- At lecture time, start Microsoft Teams on your device, and join the meeting.
 - You should be able to see the lecture meeting on your calendar, and join from there.
 - You should also be able to see the meeting from the class team, channel “General”.

Attending Lectures via Teams

- At lecture time:
 - Please keep your microphone muted, unless you have a question to ask.
